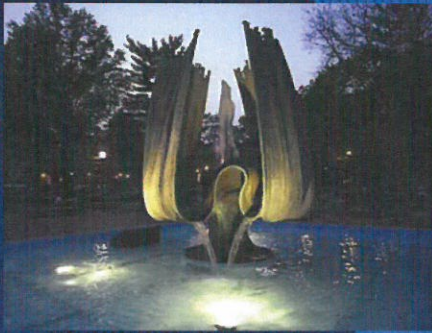


MOVIES, MINERALS & MINING

BECKLEY

Tamarack (9:00am - 10:00am)

The "Best of West Virginia." Explore this amazing gift and craft shop full of the works of West Virginia artisans. Watch artists and crafters work, taste a little bit of West Virginia at the Food Court, and explore this beautiful building and its art.

Exhibition Coal Mine (10:30am - 12:30pm)

The Exhibition Coal Mine takes you 1,500 feet underground in "man cars" operated by veteran miners. You will learn how coal was mined in the 1800's and how it is mined today.
